

Flowdrive Documentation

Add this script to your head or body in webflow

```
<!-- Flowdrive beta -->  
<script data-fd-id="your-id" src="https://files.tryflowdrive.com
```

data-fd-id : Used to store an ID in a `<script>` tag. This key is required for authentication when uploading files to a server.

- **Functionality**: Extracted at the beginning of the script to authenticate file upload requests.
- **Sample**: `<script src="upload.js" data-fd-id="YOUR_ID_HERE"></script>`

Attributes:

1. **fd-upload** : Marks elements that should be transformed into file upload widgets.
 - **Functionality**: Determines which elements are converted into custom upload widgets.
 - **Sample**: `<div fd-upload="default"></div>`
2. **fd-multiple** : Indicates whether the file input should accept multiple files.
 - **Functionality**: If present, allows multiple files to be selected and uploaded.
 - **Sample**: `<div fd-upload="default" fd-multiple></div>`
3. **fd-input** : Specifies the name of a hidden input element to be created for form submission.
 - **Functionality**: Used to store either the URL of the uploaded file or files, which can then be submitted as part of a form.

- **Sample:** `<div fd-upload="default" fd-input="uploadedFile"></div>`
4. **fd-type** : Defines the type of files that can be uploaded.
- **Functionality:** Filters the file types that the user can select for uploading. It's mapped to specific MIME types through the `fileTypeMappings` object.
 - **Sample:** `<div fd-upload="default" fd-type="image"></div>`

Setting it up

Just add these 2 attributes to any div, (preferably empty)

Working on customizations, you can have your own design do the same action :)/
